The Andresens, San Rafael residents, own and operate the Lighthouse Café restaurants in Sausalito and Corte Madera and The Lighthouse Bar & Grill in Mill Valley. Adding to the synergy of their purchase, several long-time Roadrunner Burrito employees already work at the Andresen’s other restaurants. When Roadrunner Burrito’s original owner decided to retire last year, they immediately contacted Annette and Gerner, knowing that RoadRunner was a natural addition to their restaurant group.

“We’re so pleased to be part of the Bon Air family,” said Gerner. “Annette and I often wished we could have a restaurant here, so this is a dream come true.”

The Andresens plan on staying true to the roots of this favorite Bon Air Mexican restaurant. They are refreshing the restaurant’s interior and adding new menu items. Plans are underway for a new, house-made salsa bar, expanded breakfast menu and daily specials.
